For these posts, you will be graded on the following:

Answer: You should answer the question as accurately as possible

Use of reliable sources: You should supply a bibliography and parenthetical citations for your points. These should refer to reliable, peer-reviewed secondary sources or to Oxford Music Online or another highly reliable tertiary source (neither Wikipedia nor Britannica are usually welcome on r/Askhistorians)

Succinct and readable online style: You should communicate to your audience clearly; you should not confuse the reader with a lot of jargon that only historians know
